The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program is a **FREE** program which helps individuals and families with income less than \$60,000 prepare tax returns. VITA sites open the week of January 20, 2020. IRS-certified tax preparers will help taxpayers gain access to the credits for which they are eligible, ensure accurate returns, and electronically file your return for quick processing.

Taxpayers must bring a driver's license or government-issued photo ID along with Social Security Cards or tax identification numbers for all family members. They must also have all tax-related forms (W2, Social Security Benefit Statements, 1099 forms, self-employment information, etc). In addition, taxpayers should bring healthcare information if they were enrolled in the Marketplace and receipts for charitable contributions. If possible, please bring a prior year tax return. For direct deposit, please provide account and routing numbers for both checking and savings accounts.

Many VITA sites offer drop off options for those who are unable to wait for tax returns to be prepared. Simply come in with your tax documents and fill out the necessary intake paperwork. The VITA site will copy documents, prepare and review tax returns, and call taxpayers when their return has been completed.
